- By submitting the photo and required information you are giving legal permission to the Property Owner's Association of Hilltop Lakes, Inc. to use the likeness in the course of this contest, and for current or future publicity or marketing purposes. This includes use online and in print.

- Only one entry per child may be submitted.

- By entering the Baby Photo Contest, you understand the committee or Association has no responsibility for lost photos, damaged photos, or obligation to return photos. However, every attempt will be made to ensure photos will be available for pick up at the Marketing Booth after the Independence Day Event ends.

Photos must be received at the Welcome Center no later than 5:00 p.m., Thursday, June 30, 2022. Photos cannot be accepted after that date.

When choosing the photo of your baby, toddler, or child, please ensure that the picture is of high quality and that your child is alone in the photo.

The child should be well dressed in the photo, preferably in patriotic attire. The Committee has all the rights to reject any photograph they deem unacceptable.

Photos submitted for the contest should not have any copyright restrictions. In case any issue arises; it will be the sole responsibility of the participant.

The photo should be clear, and the face should be clearly visible.

Voting for the child’s photo is simple. Everyone attending the Independence Day Celebration is eligible to vote, and votes are cast simply by public vote.

Envelopes will be available and serve as ballots. Each photo will receive a number in which the voters will write the number of their favorite candidate on the envelope and vote by donating funds which will serve to help fund “Family Amenities.”

The process is simple. The declared winner in each category is the child who receives the greatest amount of funds donated.

Voting will close at the end of the Independence Day Vendors Event at 2:00 p.m on 07/02/22.

The winners of the Baby Photo Contest will be declared after donations have been verified. Entrants from each category receiving the greatest amount of donations will be declared winners.

Winners will be notified via email or phone contact.

Winners in each category will receive a lovely certificate declaring them winners in the Baby Photo Contest.

Winners' photos will be displayed on our Website and possibly in the Local newspaper.

Participants personal contact information and details will not be shared or sold to any third party.

The Committee reserves the right to extend the contest date due to weather conditions, technical or administrative problems. Any changes will be made public and parents or legal guardians will be notified via email or telephone.
